THE NEWSLETTER FEEDING HOPE: HOW DVNF'S VFAP PROGRAM IS CHANGING LIVES – ONE GROCERY BAG AT A TIME

At the start of our 2024 fiscal year, the Disabled Veterans National Foundation (DVNF) launched a bold new initiative: the Veterans Food Assistance Program (VFAP). What began as a vision to fight hunger among disabled and at-risk veterans has rapidly evolved into one of DVNF's most impactful – and fastest-growing– programs to date.

VFAP's mission is simple but powerful: no veteran should have to choose between food and other necessities. And thanks to your support, this mission is becoming a reality.

A Solution with Immediate Impact

VFAP provides grocery assistance (up to one grant/year) for veterans facing food insecurity. From single vets living alone to families with children, the program delivers directly to their door - with dignity, efficiency, and compassion.

Each assistance level is tailored by household size, with funding ranging from \$150 for an individual to \$500 for a veteran supporting a spouse and multiple children. The DVNF team handles everything - from shopping to shipping, relieving veterans of logistical and financial stress.

These grocery deliveries aren't just bags of food – they're lifelines packed with fresh produce, protein, shelf-stable staples, and even household items like toiletries and cleaning supplies. Everything a family needs to stay fed, clean, and secure.

Food insecurity remains one of the most common and painful struggles for veterans, particularly those navigating disability, unemployment, or transitional housing. VFAP is stepping in to fill the gap with compassion and action.

- CJ3 Foundation Awarded \$15,000 in Comfort Kits and GPS support for their dedication to veterans and first responders battling PTSD and TBI.
- Foxhole Veterans Organization Received \$10,000 in Veterans Food Assistance to combat hunger among veterans reintegrating into civilian life.
- The Fire Watch Awarded \$10,000 in GPS and MP support to expand their life-saving suicide prevention efforts across Florida

All OMP Podcast awards are drawn from our direct service programs that help veterans in practical, life-changing ways:

- Veterans Food Assistance Program (VFAP) Delivers grocery support directly to food-insecure veterans and families using online shopping platforms.
- Homeless to Housing (H2H) Provides up to \$2,000 to help veterans transition from homelessness to permanent housing, including essential household goods.
- Grants to Provide Stability (GPS) Offers up to \$1,000 in emergency funds for housing, transportation, or utility bills to keep veterans stable and independent.
- Mission Possible (MP) An online platform offering stress-reducing tools and mind-body wellness programs for veterans and caregivers.
- Comfort Kits Hygiene and personal care packages distributed nationwide through Veteran Standdowns, shelters, VA hospitals, and community outreach.

Each of these programs exists to provide real support to real people – and we're inviting likeminded nonprofits to join the movement.
