Since 2016, it has hosted annual Stand Down events that offer free medical, dental, vision, legal, housing, and employment services in one location, inspired by the military concept of providing a safe space for troops to rest and recuperate. To recover, the organization operates under the motto, "A hand up, not a hand out," with the mission of connecting veterans to essential resources.
